### Garbage, Recycling and Glass Recycling

Regular Recycling day is on Monday and Trash is on Wednesday. Recyclables should be tied tightly in a container and should not be put out until the morning of pick-up. Glass recycling continues on the first Saturday of each month. If you are able, take your bottles and jars (minus the lids) to the blue bins in the recycling room behind the dumpster. The bottles and jars do not need to be bagged.

The Rescue Mission is no longer handling our recycling for our community. We have worked with Waste Connections to provide the community a recycling dumpster to continue our recycling efforts. We will be looking at providing individual recycling bins to place your recycling items in rather than the plastic bags to comply with Waste Connections' standards. More information will be provided when we have the individual bins purchased. Please continue to follow the same routine of placing your recyclables outside on Mondays. We are also looking at options of a privacy fence for better esthetic around the recycling dumpster
