Garbage, Recycling and Glass Recycling

Glass recycling continues on the first Saturday of each month for **bottles and jars** only. Do not place items on the floor next to the bins. This presents a safety hazard. Please put other glass in your regular garbage.

Resident guests staying at the Village overnight must register the guest's vehicle using the Visitor Notification form.
