**Resident's Rights Department
of Health Information**

Just a reminder that the Department of Health has a toll-free grievance and complaint hotline and is accessible 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

The number is **1.800.254.5164**.

Nursing homes are required to make this number available to residents, their guardians and family members. The number must also be posted in a public area of the Nursing and Rehab center.

Resident's rights are posted adjacent to the 2C Nurse's Station and across from the 2A Nurse's Station.
