February 3rd Virtual Voyager “Norway’s West: Fjords, Mountains, & Bergen” (Fellowship Room) 1:00 pm From sparkling fjords to majestic mountains and Bergen’s historic charm, this tour brings Norway’s wonders to life.

February 6th Life Long Learning: Michael Maloney “Rattlesnake Colonel” (Fellowship Room) 2:00 pm Thomas Cresap’s remarkable life offers an inviting window into Colonial America. A bold frontiersman, soldier, and politician, he helped drive westward expansion and navigated the era’s great conflicts. Despite his achievements, Cresap was divisive. Pennsylvanians labeled him the “Maryland Monster,” and some British officers called him the “Rattlesnake Colonel.” Yet Western Maryland settlers saw him as a folk hero, and the Iroquois fondly named him “Big Spoon” for his generosity. Admired by some and feared by others, his story—drawn from vivid historical records—brings the drama and complexity of the eighteenth-century frontier to life. **Presenter: Michael Maloney, Author & Historian**

February 9th YSO “Carmen Meets Beethoven” (Fellowship Room) 4:00 pm The concert begins with Strauss’ *Roses from the South* and Beethoven’s lighthearted *Overture to Fidelio*. From a menacing beginning to an electrifying finish, Georges Bizet’s memorable *Carmen Suites* tells the fated story of a lovestruck soldier and passionate *Carmen* in two suites. York Symphony’s Concertmaster Denise Dillenbeck shines in Nancy Ives’ *Immortal Beloved*. Ives arranged the piece to celebrate Beethoven’s unknown muse and showcases these women’s voices.

February 20th Online Lecture “Forging a Friendship – Jefferson & Madison’s Northern Journey” (Fellowship Room) 11:00 am Between May 21 and June 16, 1791, Thomas Jefferson and James Madison traveled together through Upstate New York and parts of New England. Though the new nation was in a moment of political tension, Madison said the trip was for “health, recreation and curiosity.” In honor of Presidents’ Day, join esteemed author and professor Louis Masur as he traces their journey, exploring shared interests in landscape, botany, history, and Indigenous vocabulary. This lecture draws from his latest book, *Founding Friendships: Jefferson, Madison, and the Northern Tour of 1791*, which brings new insight into the enduring bond between these two Founding Fathers — what Jefferson later called “a source of constant happiness.” **Facilitator: Gene Burk**

February 20th Movie & Discussion with Rich Santel “Brief Encounter” (Fellowship Room) 1:00 pm *Brief Encounter* follows Laura Jesson (Celia Johnson) and Dr. Alec Harvey (Trevor Howard), whose unexpected meeting sparks a poignant, restrained love affair. Supported by memorable performances from Stanley Holloway and Joyce Carey, David Lean’s film remains a beautifully crafted study of longing, duty, and heartbreak. **Runtime: 86 minutes.**
