- ✿ President John F. Kennedy founded the Peace Corps on March 1, 1961. It is a successful volunteer organization that has since sent Americans abroad to developing countries to help with health care, education, and other human needs.
- ✿ The Vernal Equinox occurs around March 20th or 21st in the northern hemisphere. This is when the sun is directly above the equator, making the day and night equal in length.
- ✿ Coca-Cola was invented by John Pemberton in March of 1886.
- ✿ The Girl Scouts was officially founded on the 12th of March 1912.
