- A guy named Bob who I met through my neighbor. He was 4 years older than me. –Sandy

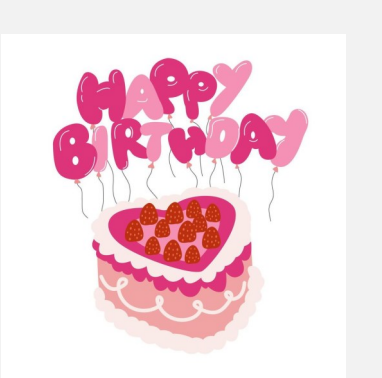
