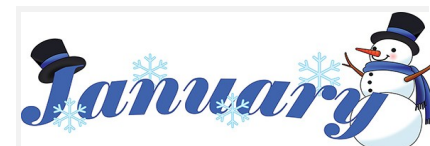
01/21– 1:00pm Melting Snowman/wood Craft:
