- 11/4 1:00pm The York County Sheriff's Office began it's K9 Unit in 2008. Since then the program has grown to a multiple K9 Program offering a wide variety of services to the County of York. The K9 Team attends specialized training to perform their duties. K9's are trained to detect explosives and illegal narcotics, search buildings, vehicles and outdoor areas, locate and recover evidence, identify suspects, track, detect firearms, and much more. - 11/11 1:00pm On Friday, February 2, 2001, a fifty-five-year-old man entered the North Hopewell-Winterstown Elementary School wielding a two-foot-long machete and randomly attacked twenty-three kindergarten children, their teacher, a third-grade teacher, and the school principal, Norina Bentzel. Although Norina and some others sustained serious injuries, no one was killed. Join Norina as she shares her firsthand experience with school tragedy, loss, and resilience.

Their greatest legacy, most people believe, is the creation of the "Milton Hershey School" (formerly the Hershey Industrial School) serving underprivileged youth since 1909. We will explore the contributions to the community and the world that we still benefit from today.
