The Story of Halloween: Light in the Darkness

Many years ago, long before Halloween looked the way it does today, people marked the changing of the seasons with festivals. As the harvest came to an end and the days grew shorter, people prepared for the long, dark winter ahead. They celebrated the blessings of the harvest and remembered those who had gone before them.

In Christian tradition, this special time became known as All Hallows' Eve, the night before All Saints' Day. All Saints' Day was set aside to honor the faithful believers—both famous saints and everyday Christians—who had shared God's love during their lives. The evening before was a time of prayer, remembrance, and preparation, and over time it came to be called Halloween.

Families would light lanterns to chase away the darkness and remind themselves of God's eternal light. In some countries, people carved turnips, gourds, and later pumpkins, placing candles inside to shine like a beacon in the night. Children and neighbors would sometimes go door to door, singing songs, saying prayers, or sharing small tokens of friendship.

As years went by, the traditions grew and changed. In America, pumpkins became the most popular lantern, and "trick-or-treating" turned into a way for children to gather sweets and enjoy a night of fun. Costumes, parties, and games became part of the celebration too.

But at the heart of Halloween lies a powerful reminder: God's light shines in the darkness, and the darkness cannot overcome it. (John 1:5) Just as a glowing pumpkin can brighten a dark porch, Christ's love lights up our lives and reminds us that we are never alone.

So today, while we enjoy the fun of costumes, candy, and community, Halloween also gives us a chance to remember the saints who came before us, to give thanks for the blessings of the harvest, and to celebrate the everlasting light of God's love.
