In the summer of 1864, President Abraham Lincoln called for 500,000 men to join the Union Army to replenish ranks depleted by disease and combat. The 200th Pennsylvania Volunteers were among the infantry regiments raised in response to this call to arms. Serving for a term of one year, the Keystoneers received initial training at Camp Curtin in Harrisburg and then were transported to Virginia, where they saw their initial action along the Bermuda Hundred Line.
