**John Maietta:** How much do you know about the state you live in? Join John in one of his popular presentations, Pennsylvania Trivia.

**The Lutheran Seminary at Gettysburg:** The Civil War, Inside and Outside Seminary Ridge Museum with Pete Miele. While the Civil War was fought outside, the conflict originated in schools, churches, and other places where ideas were shared and debated in the early nineteenth century. For almost thirty years, within the walls of the building, seminarians from north and south debated notions of freedom and what it meant to be an American. On July 1, 1863, these debates came, literally, to the back door of the Seminary as the Battle of Gettysburg erupted around the structure. Following the battle, the building was transformed into a hospital, inside which hundreds of wounded soldiers convalesced over two and a half months. This presentation promises to shed new light on the history of the Lutheran Seminary at Gettysburg and oft-overlooked topics in Civil War history.
