All residents are welcome to join your neighbors for a special bingo that will feature special "surprise" bingo prizes. *Come all!*

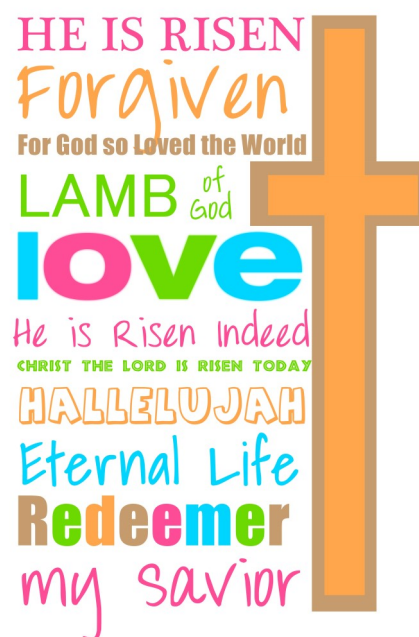
### Faith Break w/Chaplain

**Heating Up Foods** Residents are asked to make arrangements with the nursing team when needing takeout food or homemade family meals heated up for meals. Our dining services staff is ***not permitted*** to handle food from outside the facility. Please just ask the nursing team or life enrichment team to assist.

**In/Out Magnets** The in/out magnets located on the resident door frame is for emergency use only. During emergencies such as fire, each room would need to be cleared by staff and this magnet is our way to communicate that persons in that room are safe. Please do not use magnet for personal use.

**Fresh Air Walks** Residents are welcome to enjoy the outdoors on porches or maybe go for a walk in the courtyard. For safety we do recommend that you stay on the paved walkways of the courtyard. Enjoy the day!

**Extension Cords** Extension cords are not permissible in the personal care residence and individual resident rooms. Alternate resource would be a grounded surge protector. Please ask management if you have any questions or concerns. Thank you for cooperating with this safety issue.
