Fire Drills The fire drills that are conducted by the team members of the village are mandated by the federal and state guidelines that all senior living homes must follow. **The fire drills are conducted monthly at different times of the day and night.** The staff must ensure that all residents could be evacuated during a real emergency. No one ever plans for an emergency to take place in their lives however, the team members need to be prepared to take care of each resident's life. All residents are required to participate and cooperate with team members when directed. When you hear the fire alarm sound ... start moving! The team members thank everyone for their cooperation through the fire drills.

In/Out Magnets The in/out magnets located on the resident door frame is for emergency use only. During emergencies such as fire, each room would need to be cleared by staff and this magnet is our way to communicate that persons in that room are safe. Please do not use the magnet for personal use.
